What is Title I/AIS ELA and Math?

Title I is a federally funded grant run through New York State, which helps provide Academic Intervention Services (AIS) to students in English Language Arts (ELA) and Math in grades K-12.

Students in AIS are included in the regular classroom instruction for ELA and Math, just like always. They receive instruction and support in developing ELA and Math skills/strategies.

Why your child may have been selected for AIS ELA and/or Math support

- **Scoring below level of proficiency on State Exams**
- **At-risk of not meeting the New York State learning standards**
- **Teacher recommendation**

How often will my child receive AIS services?

- **The amount of time depends on student need**
- **Services are provided 2-3 times per week for a duration of 20-30 minutes**

How parents can help?

- **Talk to your children about what they're learning in school**
- **Read with your child and practice Math facts.**
- **Communicate frequently with the school.**
- **Contact the classroom teacher or AIS teacher if you have questions or concerns.**
