General Brown Central School District operates a prekindergarten through grade 2 primary building, and a grade 3 - 6 primary building located in the villages of Dexter and Glen Park as well as a grade 7 - 12 Junior-Senior High School. The District Office is located in the Junior-Senior High School building.

General Brown Central School District is principally located in Jefferson County in Northern New York State. It is approximately 3 miles northwest of Watertown and includes the villages of Dexter, Brownville, Glen Park and parts of the towns of Lyme, Pamelia, Hounsfield, and Watertown. Encompassing more than 100 square miles, the District enrolls more than 1650 students.

General Brown Central School District is committed to maintaining it's reputation as a quality rural school system fostering and encouraging academic excellence, good citizenship, and a healthy spirit of competition through it's interscholastic athletic programs.

JUNIOR-SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The high school maintains:

- Corrective programs in mathematics, reading and writing, science and social studies are provided for those identified as requiring Academic Intervention Services.
- Vocational education opportunities offered through the Bohlen Technical Center.
- 37 athletic teams that compete with neighboring schools in the Frontier League. Sports include football, basketball, wrestling, baseball, golf, soccer and lacrosse for boys and soccer, tennis, basketball, cheerleading, volleyball, lacrosse and softball for girls. All students in grades 7-12 are invited to participate.
- Music activities include marching band, senior band, junior band, senior chorus, junior chorus and select chorus (Generalaires). Students are all very active and perform throughout our area.
